

Munro-Greenhalgh 100 Charity Darts Competition – in support of Bury Hospice.

The **100** Tournament Format:

Group Stage (2.5 hours) – “First to 100”

- 8 groups (6 or 7 players per group).
- Each group plays on a designated board in a round-robin format.
- Each player will play each person in their group – best of 2 legs.

Match Format and rules:

- **Starting the Game:**
 - Each player starts at **0 points**.
 - Players take turns throwing **3 darts per turn**.
- **Scoring:**
 - Each dart's score is added to the player's total.
 - Players must be careful **not to exceed 100**.
- **Going Over 100 (Bust Rule):**
 - If a player's total **exceeds 100**, their score **remains the same** as before that turn (like a bust in regular darts).
 - Example: A player is on 95 and scores 10 → they went over 100, so their score stays at 95.
- **Winning the Game:**
 - The first player to reach exactly **100 points** wins.

For each game won **1 point** is awarded. A bonus of 1 point will also be awarded for 100 in 3 darts!

The **top 8 players overall** (based on points/wins + leg difference) qualify for the knockout stage.

Final Knockout Stage (1 hour)

All games played on one central board with walk on music for an exciting finish. (The number of games to be played will be determined by the time available)

• **Quarterfinals (8 players) – 301**

• **Semi-finals (4 players) - 301**

• **Final – 501**
